

Checklist for Ambulance Officers

Income

- ✓ PAYG Summaries
- ✓ Pensions or government payments/allowances
- ✓ Interest earned from your banks, building societies, etc.
- ✓ Dividend statements
- ✓ Details of rental income
- ✓ Details of business income
- ✓ Details of any other income earned

Deductions for Ambulance Officers

- Purchase and laundering costs of compulsory uniforms
- ✓ Protective items costs (sunglasses, sunscreen, hat, hi-vis clothing, steelcapped boots, etc.)
- ✓ Purchase costs of tools and equipment (medical equipment, electronic organisers, etc.)
- ✓ Repair and maintenance costs of workrelated tools
- ✓ Union Fees
- ✓ Machinery operating License renewals
- ✓ Travel costs associated with meetings and training offsite
- ✓ Cost of self-education courses related to the job
- ✓ Cost of overtime meals

Work and other Expenses

- ✓ Personal car expenses (estimate of km if no logbook kept, otherwise logbook and all expense items)
- ✓ Travel expenses (parking, tolls, flights, taxis/Uber, train and bus fares for training courses, trade fairs, etc.)
- Accommodation costs while working away from home
- ✓ Phone costs (for work usage)
- ✓ Percentage relating to work of computer/laptop expenses (lease or purchase)
- ✓ Percentage relating to work of internet costs
- ✓ Home office running expenses
- ✓ Work-related self-education expenses
- ✓ Last year's tax return fee
- ✓ Income protection insurance premiums (paid outside of Superannuation)
- ✓ Investment expenses (e.g. bank fees, financial advisor fees, investment borrowings, etc.)
- ✓ Donations

Other Information

- ✓ Records of sales and purchases of shares, business, or property
- ✓ Private Health Insurance details
- ✓ Spouse details including DOB and estimated taxable income
- ✓ Child(ren)'s details including DOB and evidence of any Centrelink benefits
- ✓ Details of any government debts (Child support, Centrelink ATO debt including previously written off debt)
